Both financial and scientific knowledge and skills will be required in the due diligence process, from analysis of a company's financial statements to the scientific publication to fully understand the disease area and mechanism of action of its medicines in development.

Part of the due diligence process will also involve staying up to date with the latest biotechnology market trends, engage often with a company's management team, and its competitors to understand the company and its competitive landscape best.

On top of the analysis work, you will also support the portfolio manager in the daily operations and communications of the fund.

- Screen for investment candidates through the 700+ companies in the biotech industry
- Conduct full fundamental analysis of promising selected biotech companies, including financial modeling and understanding of scientific literature
- Interact on a regular basis with the management teams of relevant biotech companies
- Attend meetings and conferences, with all related travelling
- Interact on a regular basis with sell-side analysts and banks to help keep up with latest trends and facilitate meetings with management teams of interesting companies
- Support the portfolio manager in the daily operations and communications of the fund
